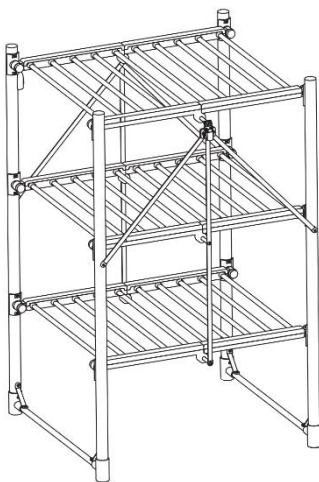

Safety Instructions

Important note:

Please read this booklet before installing and switching on this appliance. The manufacturer assumes no responsibility for incorrect installation and usage as described in this booklet.

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- If the supply lead is damaged it must be replaced by a qualified person using the correct lead, available from **0345 209 7461**.
- Packaging material is dangerous to children. Never allow children to play with packaging material.
- Check the appliance for damage after unpacking it. Do not connect the appliance if it has been damaged in transport.
- The appliance can only be used safely if it is correctly installed according to the safety instructions. The installer is responsible for ensuring that the appliance works correctly after installation.
- A defective appliance may cause electric shock. Never switch on a defective appliance. Unplug the appliance from the mains or switch off the circuit breaker in the fuse box. Contact the customer services.
- The appliance is not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote control system.
- This appliance is intended for domestic use and the household environment only. The appliance is not intended for use outside.

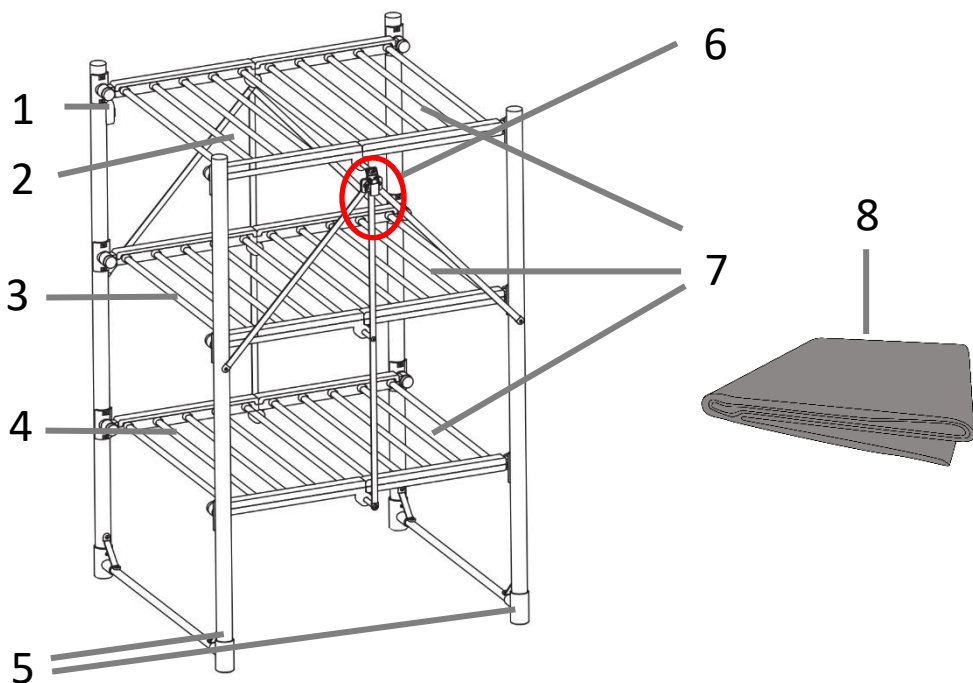
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Safety Instructions

- Do not tamper with the appliance. If necessary, call our customer helpline.
- Do not switch on the appliance if it is damaged in any way. Contact our customer helpline.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended during operation. The manufacturer is not liable for damage which is caused by improper use or incorrect operation.
- The accessible parts become very hot when in operation. Never touch hot parts. Keep children at a safe distance.
- In the event of a malfunction, turn off the appliance's electricity supply. For repairs, call customer services.
- Ensure that your mains voltage corresponds to that stated on the appliance.
- The appliance should be connected to an earthed main socket.
- Before cleaning, always unplug the appliance from the power supply.
- Repairs can only be undertaken by a competent qualified electrician.
- This appliance is intended only for drying textiles washed in water.

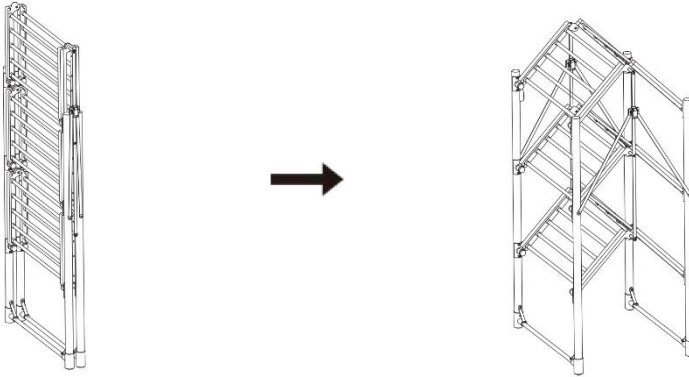
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Usage

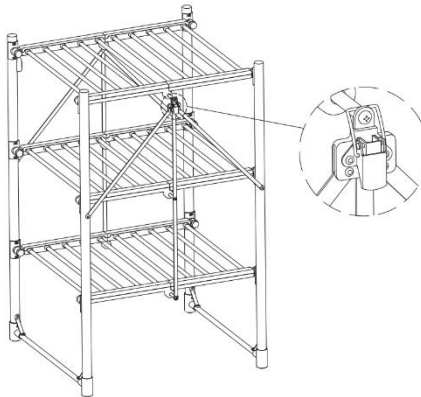
Note: When opening/unfolding and closing/folding the clothes airer then please be careful to not trap your fingers or hands.

To use the clothes airer please follow the below steps:

1. Unfold the clothes airer so it is slightly open (approximately 30°), ensuring the legs are stable, the clothes airer is fully upright and placed on a stable floor.



2. Fully unfold the airer and ensure it is fully open/horizontal and the arms are fully extended and all the clips are locked. Be careful to not trap your fingers or hands.



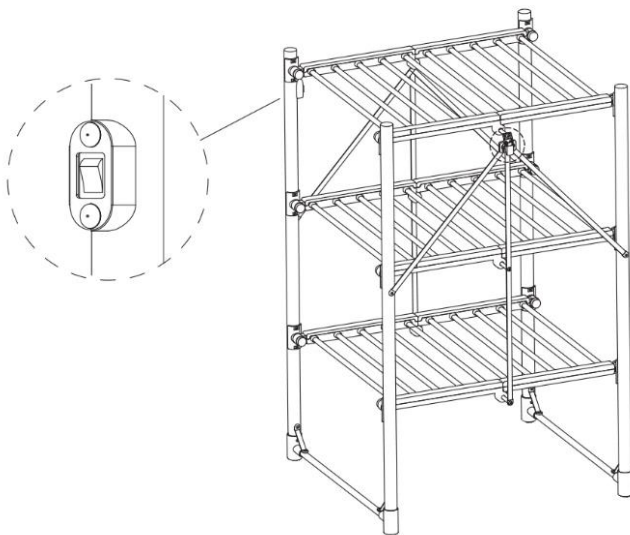
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Usage

Note: When opening/unfolding and closing/folding the clothes airer then please be careful to not trap your fingers or hands.

3. Plug the appliance into an earthed mains socket. Locate the power switch which is on the side of the unit and press the switch to the ON position, the light will illuminate. After a short period of time (approximately 5-10 mins) the electric clothes rack will reach its operation temperature. Put the laundry on the airer as required and if required place the cover over the airer and the clothes (by using the cover the laundry should dry faster).

Max load (kg)	Total – 30kg Single layer – 10kg
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4. Switch off after use. Allow to cool down before closing/unfolding. Be careful to not trap your fingers or hands.

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Cleaning and Maintenance:

How to clean:

- Clean the surface of each pole with a warm damp cloth and allow to dry.

Trouble Shooting:

Problem	Solution
The appliance doesn't work	Check that the appliance is switched on.
	Check that there has not been a power cut.
	Check that the plug is not faulty.
	Check that the fuse has not blown.
	Check that the voltage is correct for the appliance.

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Guarantee

This product is guaranteed for **12 months** from the date of the original purchase. If any defect arises due to faulty materials or workmanship, the faulty product must be returned to the place of purchase. Refund or replacement is at the discretion of the retailer.

The following conditions apply:

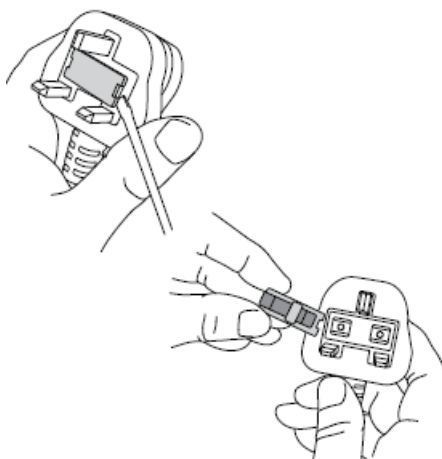
This appliance is designed to operate from a mains supply of 220-240V~50Hz.

Check that the voltage marked on the product corresponds with your supply voltage.

How to change the fuse

1. Slot the end of a screwdriver into the recess in the fuse holder of the plug.
2. Pull the fuse holder upwards until free of the plug and slide the fuse out.
3. Replace the fuse and replace fuse holder, pushing down until locked into place.

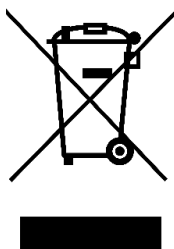
Important: Only ever use a 5 amp fuse.
